PERIMETER COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP INSTRUCTIONS

- Please review the Frequently Asked Questions to better understand the scholarship process at Perimeter College <https://perimeter.gsu.edu/student-accounts/scholarships/>. You will find the answers to most questions via this medium.
- You must be returning to Perimeter College for the Fall 2021 semester to be eligible for scholarships. **These scholarships will not be posted to recipients' accounts until the Fall 2021 semester and cannot transfer to other colleges within Georgia State University.**
- Our process has moved online because of COVID-19. Please allow focused time to complete applications, write and review required essays, request recommendations, and follow up with recommenders. All scholarship applications will disable at **5:00 PM EST on Thursday, July 1, 2021**. We will not consider late or incomplete applications.
- Carefully review available scholarship opportunities and determine the scholarships for which you meet the criteria. Apply only for the scholarship(s) in which you meet all of the listed criteria.
- Most available scholarships require essays as part of the application process. We advise applicants to write all essays in a word processing software. Essays can then be copied and pasted into online applications.
- **Please do not type your application or essay responses in all caps or all lowercase.**
- **May I use the same letter of recommendation for multiple scholarship opportunities?** Yes, as long as the letter of recommendation is from the appropriate source. Please see our Frequently Asked Questions page for more discussion on this topic.
- **How will I know if my recommender submitted my letter of recommendation?** The application system will send an automated email after a recommendation is submitted on your behalf as long as your recommender enters your correct email address in the recommendation survey. Please see our Frequently Asked Questions page for more discussion on this topic. We cannot confirm if we have received a recommendation because of the volume of applications we receive.
- **What happens after I submit a scholarship application? When will scholarship recipients be notified?** The application system will send you a confirmation email with the next steps and our approximate notification date. Due to the volume of applications, we receive, we cannot respond to requests for updates. Please review our Frequently Asked Questions and your confirmation email for notification information.

Students who will not be returning to Perimeter College for the Fall 2021 semester should not apply for these scholarships. Funds for these scholarships will not be posted to student accounts until the Fall 2021 semester and cannot be transferred to other colleges within GSU.

GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

General scholarship opportunities put qualified applicants in the running for multiple scholarships grouped by criteria. General scholarship opportunities receive many applicants. Please also consider applying for individual scholarship opportunities.

PERIMETER COLLEGE RETURNING STUDENTS SCHOLARSHIPS

Criteria (you must meet all of the listed criteria to apply):

- Perimeter College students enrolled in at least 6 credit hours for the Summer 2021 semester.
- Have a 2.80 or higher cumulative GPA.
 - If you meet all of the criteria listed above, complete the application at https://gsu.qualtrics.com/jfe/form/SV_6R3trvUKC1LP0dE.

Essay requirement: The application requires two essay questions. Essay prompts are as follows:

1. *What are your career and educational goals? Why did you decide to attend Perimeter College?*
***This is a two-part essay question. The suggested length is 500 words.**
2. *Please outline and detail your need for scholarship support. Why do you need a scholarship?*
***This is a two-part essay question. The suggested length is 200 words.**

Letter of recommendation requirement: The application requires a letter of recommendation from a Perimeter College faculty member. We will not consider letters from PC staff members. Recommenders should complete the recommendation survey at https://gsu.qualtrics.com/jfe/form/SV_brRDNhsbZWa0t5Y.

MILITARY SCHOLARSHIPS

Criteria (you must meet all of the listed criteria to apply):

- Perimeter College students are honorably discharged veterans, active-duty service members, in the National Guard Reserves, or dependents of veterans.
- No minimum GPA is required to apply.
 - If you meet all of the criteria listed above, please complete the application at https://gsu.qualtrics.com/jfe/form/SV_7P4rUoN5nsEh9lk.

Essay requirement: The application requires two essay questions. Essay prompts are as follows:

1. *Why did you join the military? How has being associated with the military made a difference in your life? What are your career and educational goals?* ***This is a three-part essay question. Suggested length is 500 words.**
2. *Please outline and detail your need for scholarship support. Why do you need a scholarship?*
***This is a two-part essay question. Suggested length is 200 words.**

Letter of recommendation requirement: The application requires a letter of recommendation from a Perimeter College faculty or staff member or non-related professional. Recommenders should complete the recommendation survey at https://gsu.qualtrics.com/jfe/form/SV_1Amxho5nPYZnlfU.

Proof of military service requirement: The application requires proof of military service. Please email a copy of your DD-214 form (PLEASE BLACK OUT SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS) to pcscholarships@gsu.edu. Alternatively, you may have a military advocate complete the following survey on your behalf https://gsu.qualtrics.com/jfe/form/SV_3R8y94sUSjflDAq. SPECIAL CRITERIA

JACK AND KATHLEEN THORNTON SCHOLARSHIP

Criteria (you must meet all of the listed criteria to apply):

- Perimeter College students enrolled for the Summer 2021 semester.
- Interested in having a career in writing i.e. you want to work in media, author books, etc.
- Have a 3.00 or higher cumulative GPA.
 - If you meet all of the criteria listed above, please complete the application at https://gsu.qualtrics.com/jfe/form/SV_9nbfVkiBIFPDIB8.

Essay requirement: The application requires an essay question. The essay prompt is as follows:

1. *What are your career and educational goals? Please outline your interest in having a career as a writer, why do you want to have a career in writing? (This essay should outline your career interest in writing, applicants who do not write on the prompt will not be considered). *This is a two-part essay question. Suggested length is 500 words.*

Scholarship Amount: Amount to be determined by the scholarship selection committee. Funds may be used for tuition, fees, books, and educational expenses.

PC MATH MAJORS SCHOLARSHIP

- Perimeter College students from underrepresented populations who are majoring in mathematics.
- No minimum GPA is required to apply.

Essay requirement: The application requires an essay response. The essay prompt is as follows:

1. *Please outline and detail your need for scholarship support. Why do you need a scholarship?*

***This is a two-part essay question. The suggested length is 200 words.**
